

Doctors of Garo Hills examine their own Hospitals and evaluated health infrastructure under IIM Shillong's Guidance



NRHM and State Govt. have taken the advice of IIM Shillong for designing and delivering hospital care system more patients friendly and also socially responsible. **IIM Shillong has trained the second batch of 14 doctors (Garo Hills) under 15 credit IIM certificate programme –Sustainable Healthcare Management System.** During this process doctors learned how to lead from the front during crisis, motivate their staff under stress, read financial statements and preparing zero based budgets and making financial planning for their units/hospitals by utilizing NRHM schemes, WHO norms, MCI guidelines, Government regulations. They also realised the potential of their own health infrastructure for grooming a disease free healthy population in Meghalaya during 2020.

The participants underwent self analysis on their personality, professional growth/exposure, SWOT analysis of their capabilities for building a new patient friendly healthcare system in Garo Hills during their stay in IIM Shillong. Now all of them will undergo for a post training evaluation under **Prof. Shajahan** for assessing the impact of training in their working environment. The Training for next batch of Doctors will commence in June 2012 for a period of 30 days.

Dr. Nitish Sengupta Inspires Future Managers at IIMS



The students of IIM Shillong were privileged to have an extremely insightful and illuminating interactive session with **Dr. Nitish Sengupta, Chairman of the Board for Reconstruction for Central Public Sector Enterprises.**

Dr. Sengupta is a multifaceted personality who has lent valuable contribution to the country as Revenue Secretary of the Government of India and Member Secretary of the Indian Planning commission. He has also represented India in the UN Commission on Transnational Corporations and was elected as Chairman 1981-82. After retirement, he became Director General, IMI and led from the front to develop it into one of the leading management schools of the day.

Dr. Sengupta started the discussion with the economic upheaval that the world and India in particular, was going through. He discussed at length the economic policies followed in India, starting with the era of the License Raj to the liberalization reforms in 1991 to how our country was affected by the latest economic crisis of 2008. He also deliberated on the current position of PSUs in India, clearing the various misconceptions that student community generally had regarding them. He explained that the public sector is doing really well and that this sector is an attractive career proposition that young managers should seriously consider.

The discussion was interspersed with interesting anecdotes about **Dr. Sengupta's** interactions with other famous personalities, **the late Prime Ministers Mr. Rajiv Gandhi and Mr. P.V. Narasimha Rao,** to name a few. The student community of IIM Shillong greatly benefited from these rich and diverse experiences of **Mr. Sengupta.**

The extensive knowledge, enthusiasm and liveliness that **Dr. Sengupta** displayed were unmatched even by the young students of the institute. It was a delightful experience for each and every person present in the session and the learnings from this interaction would be remembered by all for a long time to come.
