Kisan Diwas is observed to honour India's farmers and to commemorate the birth anniversary of the **India's 5<sup>th</sup> Prime Minister, Shri Choudhary Charan Singh**.

This day aims to raise awareness of the importance of farmers and their valuable contribution to the nation's overall social and economic development. This month infographic aims at highlighting the initiatives taken by the Government of India in improving the income and standard of living of farmers mainly focus to NER.

### Key Initiatives



**Budget allocation** for Department of Agriculture: Rs. 1,23017.57 Crore in 2021-22



**Food grain production** has increased from 265.05 million tonnes in 2013-14 to 305.43 million tonnes in 2020-21, the highest level ever.



**Horticulture production** in India has increased from 280.99 million tonnes in 2014-15 to 320.48 million tonnes in 2020-21, the highest level ever.



646 startups in agriculture and allied sectors have been selected (till 31st March 2021) for funding of **Rs. 69.92 crore**



Fixing of **MSP** at One and a half times the cost of production



Increase of MSP for all mandated Kharif, Rabi and other **commercial crops** with a return of atleast 50%



**MSP** for Paddy increased for 43% of Rs.1868 per quintal in 2020-21



**MSP** for Wheat increased to Rs 1975 per quintal in 2020-21 as against Rs 1400 per quintal in 2013-14



Rs 1.6 lakhs crores released to more than 11.5 crore farmer families under **PM-KISAN**



29.22 crore farmers have enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (**PMFBY**)



**260.60 lakh new Kisan Credit Cards** were issued and amount of Rs. 2,76,780 crore were sanctioned



**Soil Health Card** issued to 11 crore farmers



**Under Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY)** 19043 clusters have been formed and an area of 3.81 ha has been covered benefitting 9.52 lakh farmers



**Mission Organic Value Chain Development** in NER launched. 170 companies have been formed comprising of 1.53 lakh farmers covering 4.09 lakh ha area



**Neem Coating Urea** introduced



**Agri Infrastructure Fund (AIF) launched** and it has mobilized Rs 7700 crore worth agriculture infrastructure having more than 7300 projects



**10,000 FPOs** launched with a budgetary provision of Rs 6865 crore in February 2020



**National Bee and Honey Mission (NBHM)** launched in 2020 with a budget allocation of Rs. 500 Crore



Rs. 4000.00 crore allocated under **Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY\_PDMC)**. 20.39 lakh hectare has been covered and about 16 lakh farmers were benefitted under micro irrigation



**Rs. 4878.31 crore** allocated for agricultural mechanization and 13,24,745 number of machines and equipment have been provided to farmers on subsidy.



**18 states and 3 UTs, 1000 markets** have been integrated with the **National Agricultural Market (e-NAM) scheme**

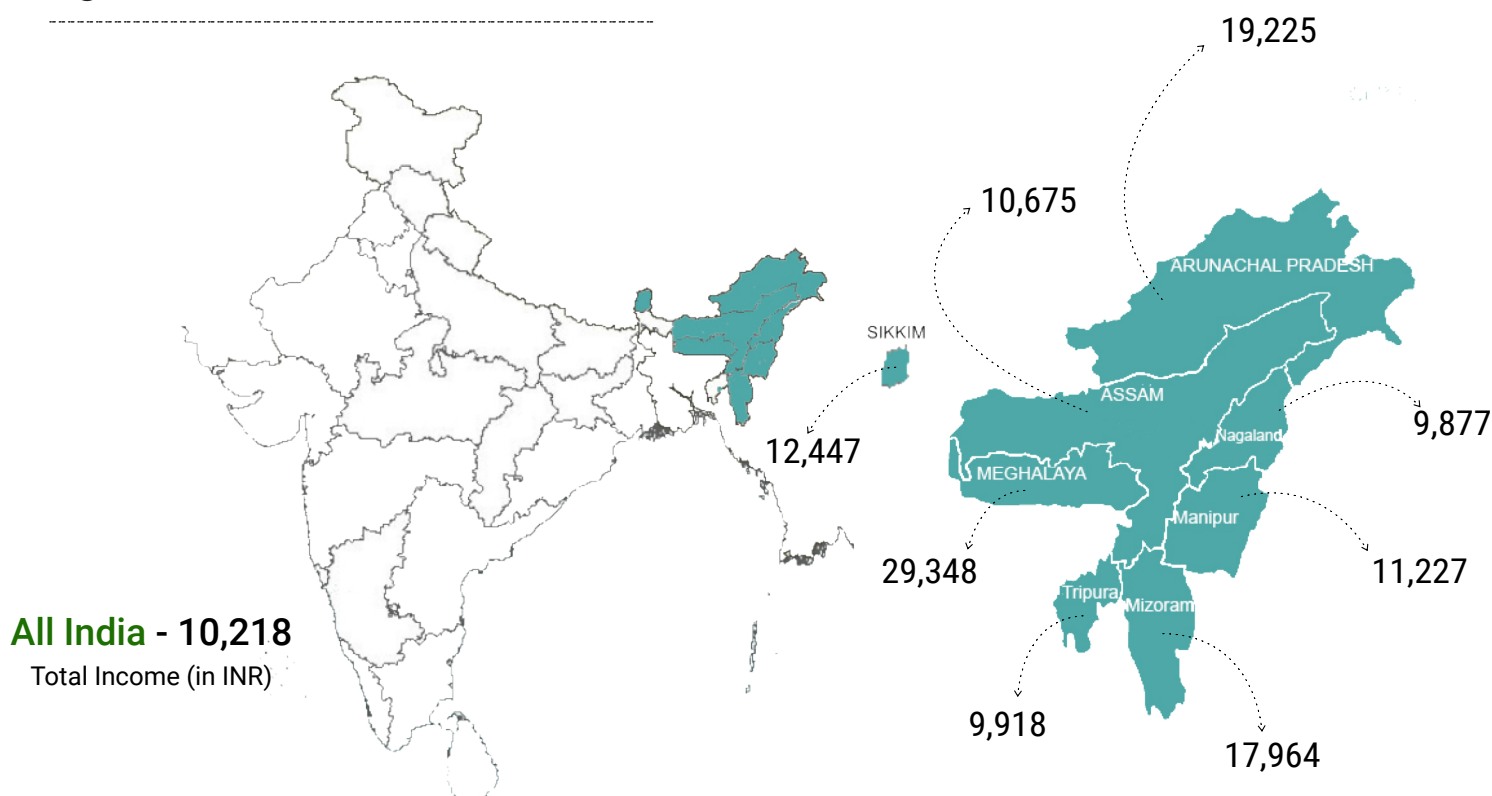
