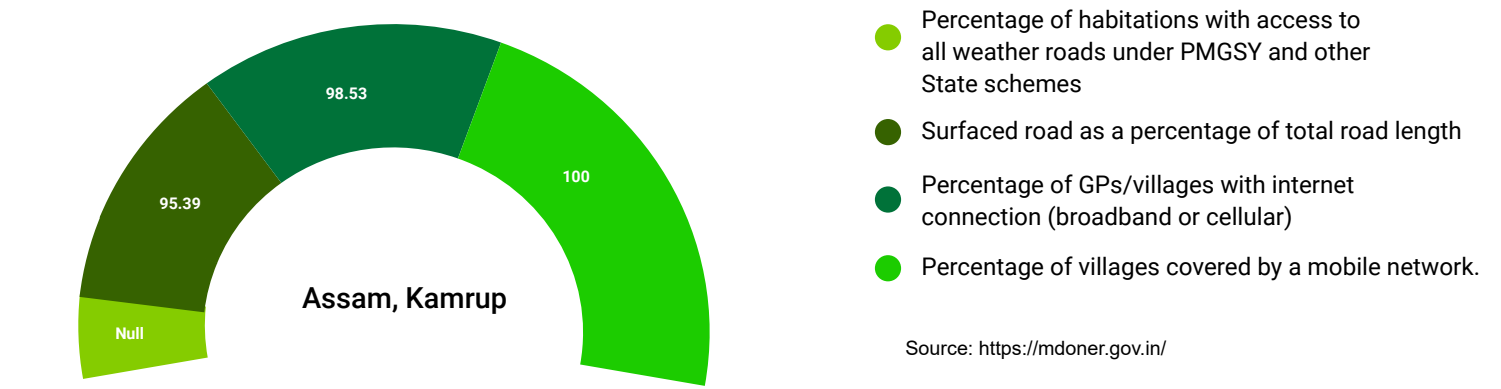

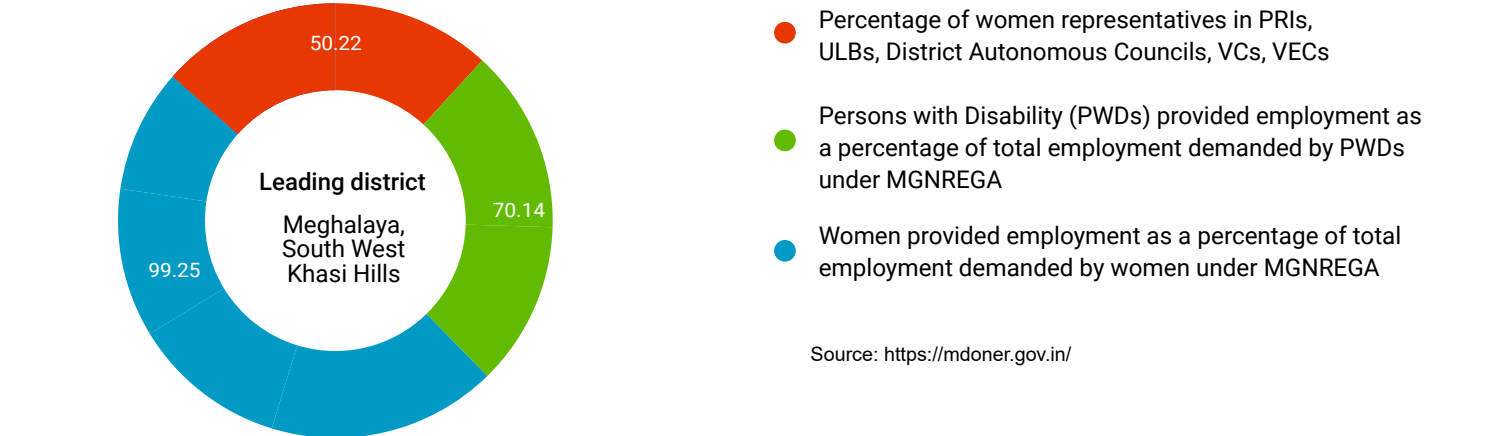

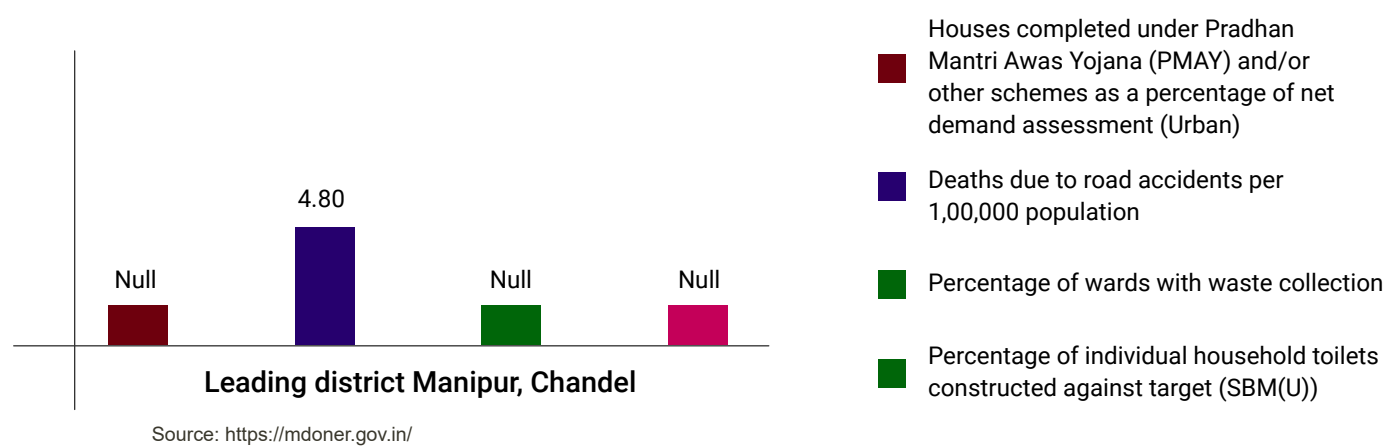

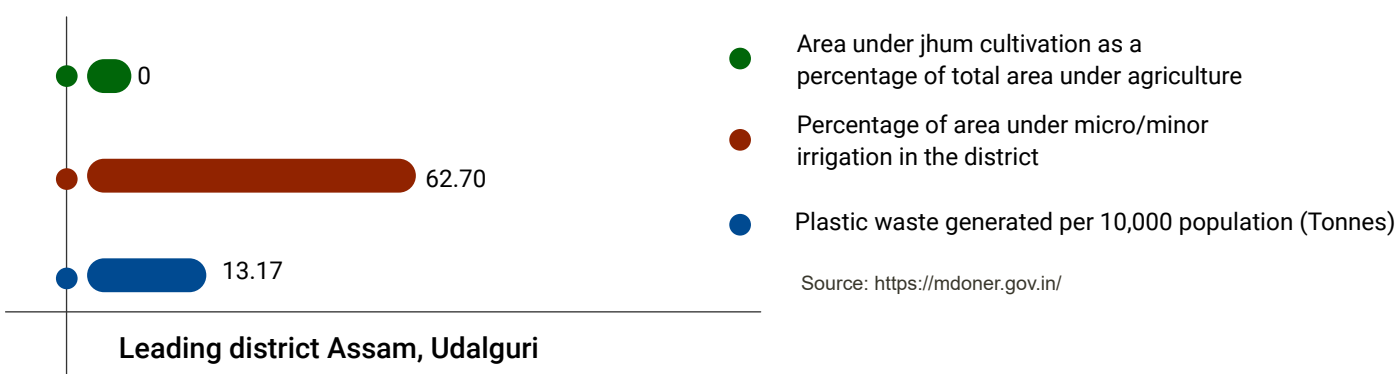
Statistics for leading state in 'Reduced Inequalities'



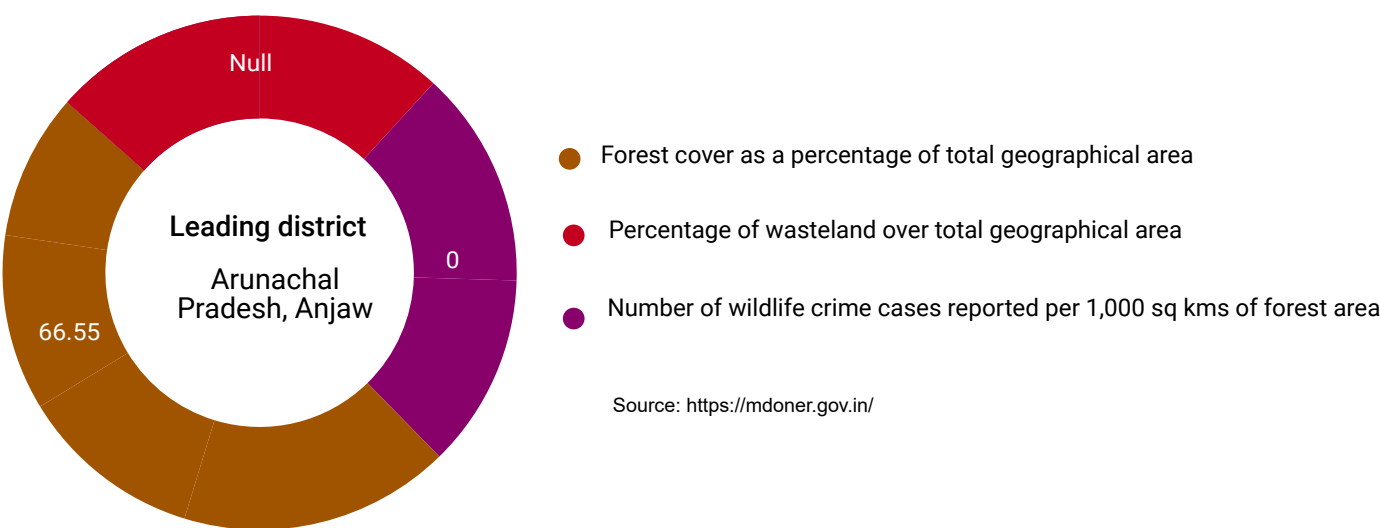

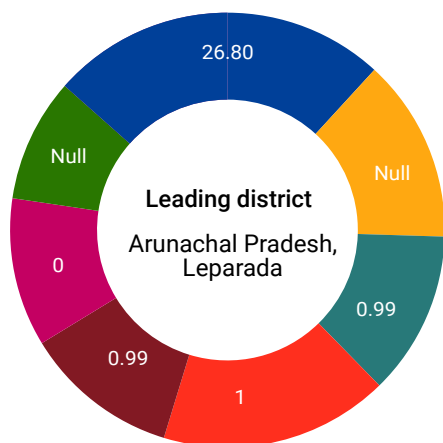

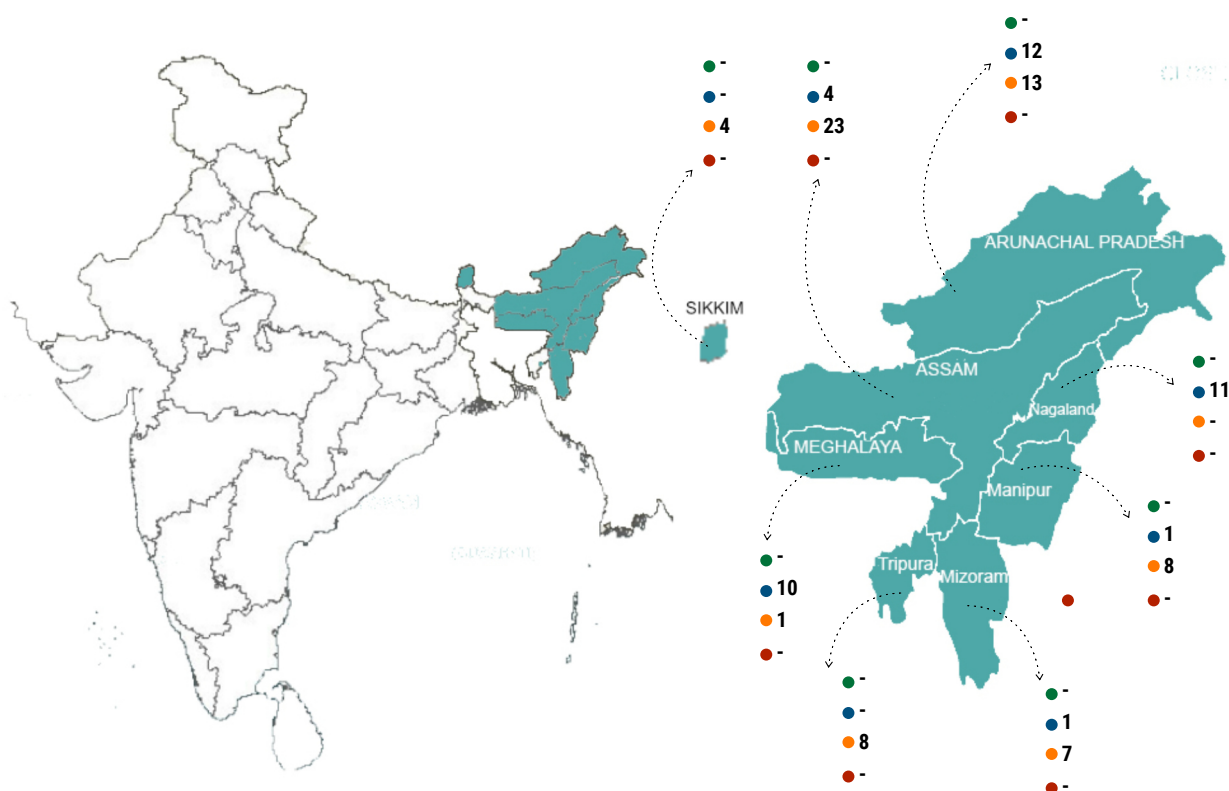
