EmergeE 2023, Facilitating Growth and Innovation at IIM Shillong

The Entrepreneurship Cell of the Indian Institute of Management, Shillong orchestrated the thirteenth edition of the EmergeE on the 14th and 15th October, 2023, organised by the institution, showcasing a dynamic exhibition of innovation and entrepreneurship. The event allowed the gathering of business owners, policy makers, entrepreneurs and startup incubators who share a common goal of strengthening the startup ecosystem in Northeast India.

The overarching theme for the day was 'Envisioning India at 100, Empowering Innovation and Growth', with an emphasis placed on the importance of regional businesses in the process of progress, as reiterated by Shri PVSLN Murty, Chairman and Managing Director of the Northeastern Development Finance Corporation (NEDFi) in his speech. Professor DP Goyal, Director of IIM, Shillong reaffirmed the institution's dedication to fostering indigenous businesses.

During the thought leadership talk, Secretary Atul



The topics of other discussions delivered on that day included sustainable startup revenue models, and strategic planning with an emphasis on fiscal prudence.

EmergeE provided a platform for thirty five startups to present their ventures and share stories from their journey. Among those thirty five startups, seven were regional, and they presented their concepts to prospective investors. The event was a colossal milestone which fostered connectivity within the startup community, strengthening it, promising a future where sustainable firms thrive and contribute to the prosperity of the country.

Neo Bank: A Bank Without Brick-and-Motor Existence

"At 2030, I would say that you probably have two billion people that'll be using day-to-day banking services, independent of banks." Brett King

With the annual growth of 13.24 % during 2022-23, India is being featured as the fastest growing economy on the digital payment landscape. Currently 40% of the world's digital banking transactions are initiated in India.

With the aim of financial inclusion, the government launched 75 digital banking units (DBUs) across the country last year. SBI being the pioneer of such an idea, focussed on large cities earlier. DBU requires minimum human intervention but as support, a team is placed in a branch during day hours to guide and resolve issues of the users. These branches operate 24X7 in a self-service mode, hence relieving users to possess any device to enable such facilities. A further upgradation to this is offered by Punjab National Bank, by opening a new branch, "PNB Metaverse", that is completely digital and promises to offer 3D experience to its customers.

Despite digital banking in place, it is observed that our traditional banks are unable to meet the needs of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) which require cheap and more customized solutions for their financial needs. Also, a report by Niti Aayog has suggested recently that full stack digital banks may serve as a solution for credit penetration. All these factors support a new concept of banks in banking industry, which are termed as Neo Banks. These banks are different as they do not have any brick-and-motor existence, and are completely digital. These banks exist independently (full stack) in certain countries like United Kingdom, Brazil, Germany and South Africa. In India, in the absence of any specific regulations for such banks, to operate, they must partner with a traditional bank. For example, Jupiter is a neo bank partnered with Federal bank.



Currently these banks are offering products that come under the regulation of all - RBI, SEBI and IRDA. Neo banks are catering heavily to the needs of MSME and Millennials. MSME require cheap solutions and due to their risky operations, such products are not easily available through formal channels. Thus, they are heavily dependent on informal channels. Millennials, also lack patience to go through formal procedures of traditional banking and hence are attracted to such technological innovations.

Given their immense strong attributes these banks have enough potential to grow and offer unique solutions to corporates, government and other fintech service providers. To carve a strong foundation for themselves, they may have to deal with a wider audience who still prefer reliable brick- and- motor solutions. There is a long road ahead with challenges posing in the form of cyber security and data solutions, regulations and compliances and more unique products providing enough attraction to the public at large.

At the same time, it is important for all of us to understand the changing landscape, and be prepared to educate ourselves and get comfortable with advanced technological financial solutions to provide reliable, safe and cost-effective financial solutions to manage our ventures and personal finance.

He further drove the point across by dissecting the journey that a consumer goes through into the broad categories of mind, stimulus, and, finally, action. Here, the mind represents the insights that marketers need

Both cohorts of the Post Graduate Programme (PGP) had the privilege of engaging with Mr. Dash. The workshop gave participants invaluable insights into the world of effective advertising and the science behind it, contributing profoundly to their holistic development.

The lecture underscored that data science is a collaborative effort, advocating the CRISP DM approach.

The lecture highlighted that both traditional and Generative AI can and will coexist. Mr. Oppiliappan emphasized the importance of prompt engineering and leadership in AI adoption. As future managers the audience were encouraged to develop an AI mindset, interpret algorithms, make informed trade-offs, and find faster ways to generate value. As AI continues to shape the corporate landscape, embracing it as an essential tool for informed decision-making is imperative. The synergy between managers and AI is the path to success in the ever-evolving business world.
