FACULTY DESK Supply Chain is Getting Digitized at a Faster Rate Than You Think



Supply chains (SCs) are all around us. Everything we wear, eat, touch or use every day comes to us through some form of supply chain. Moreover, it processes raw materials from some other location to one place to finish the product at another place. Technically, a supply chain consists of all parties involved, directly or indirectly, in fulfilling a customer's request. In other words, it can either be a single player or a network of groups of suppliers, manufacturers, distribution centers, retailers and customers. So, it is more appropriate to call it a supply network or supply web. The supply chain literally connects the world through its network and is often known as the heart of the global economy.

SC has a dynamic nature and changes are more often than expected. In recent times, SCs have been going through a major transformation including digitization at a significant rate. Thanks to recent developments technology and successful use cases of in blockchain, digital twin, drone delivery, autonomous transportation, cobots, IoT, AI, machine learning, data analytics and automation in SC. McKinsey's concept of the 'next-generation digital supply chain', ought to SC leaders to "place sensors in everything, create networks everywhere, automate anything and analyse everything to significantly improve performance and customer satisfaction." This will change the way business will be done in the future. A digital SC would help to achieve greater traceability, decrease logistics costs, and improve decisionmaking on all fronts. Avaya LLC is an American multinational technology company. Through digital transformation, their SC cost and net inventory cash decreased by 50% and 94% respectively. Henkel is another organization which is known for their SC excellence. They have a clear goal of minimum input and maximum performance where digitization of their SC plays a critical role. With digital technology, tracking becomes accessible and allows production teams to adapt to any changes in customer demand in real time. Through digitizing the manual processes, Henkel is able to quickly gather data, identify trends and improve efficiency and quality in its production facilities. Consider another example of Pfizer vaccine SC, where time is an important consideration in logistics leading to a need for higher transportation speed. Pfizer started their digital transformational journey in 2012 by moving the SC to the cloud. Pfizer has more than 24,000 SKUs and around 200 contract manufacturers in 175 countries which makes it critical to track. Hence, another upgrade was carried out in 2016 to attain higher traceability. Furthermore, it led to quicker response to changes in market demand as well as better factory preparedness for any new changes. They also moved to e-commerce by offering prescription drugs available online. This further reduced their logistics cost and improved bottomto-up forecasting of various drugs. Pfizer has also launched the "Highly Orchestrated Supply Network (HOSuN)" to provide support to its customers through strengthening the SC at every echelon to achieve this goal. Pfizer's "Digital Companion" provides solutions and tools on digital channels to help patients and providers in various ways. The company is also using Al and machine learning to enhance the accuracy and speed of decision-making at various levels.

In today's world, if we look at any company, they are thriving for digital transformation, and digitizing their SC is key in this journey. Thus, opportunities lie for students to hone their digital skills, gain interdisciplinary knowledge and prepare themselves for this transformational journey. Because the race is on and sooner or later the industries will either perish or transform into the digital age.


Stories that Inspire: IIM Shillong Scholars Shine with Aditya Birla and OP Jindal Scholarships

Celebrating Entrepreneurial Spirit: Launch of Coffee Table Book on 75 Young Entrepreneurs from North East India


