customized capsule training is designed to ignite the spirit amongst the young faculty members and to facilitate them in developing a right approach towards teaching-learning and research methodologies. The course will cover important areas of management education, approach, tools, concepts, research and training, contemporary participant-centric pedagogies, and Institution building. After completion of the training program the participants will be prepared towards cognitive and critical thinking, right approach and orientation towards management education, outcome-based research framework and methodologies etc.

Objectives:

The summer school focuses on training young faculty members in two critical areas of development: teaching and research. The course is designed to facilitate young faculty members in developing a positive and open mindset in teaching and research.

Thrust areas:

- ❖ Teaching: Anchor academic rigour, contemporary teaching methodologies, content and curriculum development, embracing technology in teaching, enhancing teaching - learning ecosystems.
- ❖ Research: Research fundamentals, research methodology, statistical reasoning, academic writing, reference management, literature reviews, and research proposal writing.

Expected Outcome:

At the end of the training the participants will be able to:

- ❖ Develop and refine their teaching techniques, strategies, and methodologies.
- ❖ Can engage classroom with better, improved and innovative teaching techniques, strategies and methodologies.
- ❖ Can enhance their courses by gaining knowledge on curriculum design, alignment with learning outcomes, and assessment strategies.
- ❖ Can enhance faculty perspectives, promote interdisciplinary collaboration, and inspire innovative teaching methods.
- ❖ Improve research skills and competencies through clear understanding of research methodologies, data analysis techniques, and academic writing.
- ❖ Embrace new tool and technology for seamless and quality academic writing.

Course Delivery Design

- 4 days
- 24 hrs planned into 16 sessions of 1.5 hrs each.

Eligibility Criteria:

Any faculty members working as full time Associate/ Assistant Professor in a recognized University/HEI in NER.

Nomination Process:

Nomination has to be made by the VC/ Director of the respective Institute/ University. Nominations may be made by the head of the institute by email on or before 30-04-2024 to apjcentre@iimshillong.ac.in. The nomination will be considered on the first come first serve basis only.
