

Strengthening Pathways of Growth: Director-in-Charge's Engagements – May 2025

The month of May 2025 marked an energetic beginning under the leadership of Prof. Naliniprava Tripathy, Director (In-Charge), IIM Shillong. Her tenure began with a strong focus

on continuity, collaboration, and community engagement, ensuring that the Institute's vision of sustainable and inclusive growth remained at the forefront.





Strategic Collaborations and Academic Initiatives



The Institute entered into several significant partnerships that reinforced its commitment to knowledge sharing and regional capacity building. On 3rd May 2025, IIM Shillong signed an MoU with the Rural Development (Panchayat) Department,



Government of Tripura, to provide leadership and management training for elected representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions. This collaboration reflected the Institute's dedication to grassroots governance and policy impact in the North East.



Furthering executive education, a **five-day Customized Executive General Management Programme** for officers of the **Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru**, was conducted from 28th April to 2nd May, setting a high academictone at the start of the month. Later in

May, from 19th to 23rd, the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) on Nurturing Future Leadership strengthened IIM Shillong's role as a national hub for faculty development.
