LEAD-2025 at IIM Shillong: Unlocking Human Potential Through Technology and Analytics



IIM Shillong inaugurated the Leveraging Emerging Technologies and Analytics for Development (LEAD)-2025 Conference on December 10, 2025, setting the stage for a thought-provoking dialogue on the theme "Unlocking Human Potential." The conference brought together eminent scholars, policymakers, industry leaders, and practitioners to explore how emerging technologies and data-driven insights can drive inclusive growth, strengthen governance, and enable evidence-based decision-making.

Setting the context for the conference, Prof. Pradeep Kumar Dadabada, Co-chairperson, LEAD-2025, underscored the imperative of responsible and ethical use of technology in addressing complex societal challenges. He highlighted the role of analytics and information systems in bridging developmental gaps while ensuring inclusivity and sustainability.

Welcoming the gathering, Prof. Naliniprava Tripathy, Director (I/C), IIM Shillong, offered a distinctive perspective on the conference theme by drawing from Vedic philosophy,



linking ancient wisdom with contemporary approaches to technology and development. She emphasized that unlocking human potential requires a balanced integration of technological advancement with human values and ethical grounding. Reaffirming IIM Shillong's commitment, she highlighted the Institute's role as a convenor of academia, industry, and government in co-creating scalable and sustainable solutions for societal progress.

The inaugural session was further enriched by insights from Dr. Viswanath Venkatesh, Eminent Scholar and Verizon Chair of Business Information Technology at Virginia Tech, who shared global perspectives on the transformative potential of context-aware technologies. He stressed that the success of technological interventions depends not only on innovation, but also on a deep understanding of human behaviour and local contexts in design and implementation.

Adding a practitioner's perspective, Mr. Anand, Technology Advisor, Assam Electronics Development Corporation Ltd. (AMTRON), highlighted the critical role of public-private

collaboration in scaling digital infrastructure and enabling AI-driven governance. He emphasized the need for rapid yet inclusive digital transformation to ensure that technological progress remains accessible and future-ready.

A significant moment of the inaugural session was the release of the LEAD-2025 Book of Abstracts by the dignitaries, symbolising the conference's rich and diverse body of scholarly contributions and its growing stature in the information systems and analytics domain.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Prof. Parijat Upadhyay, Co-chairperson, LEAD-2025, who acknowledged the efforts of the organizing team, speakers, participants, and partners in shaping LEAD as a vibrant and evolving platform for academic and practitioner engagement.

LEAD-2025 thus reaffirmed IIM Shillong's commitment to advancing conversations at the intersection of technology, analytics, and human development—placing people at the heart of innovation and progress.

IIM Shillong proudly inaugurated the 23rd AIMS International Conference on Management (AIMS~23) on December 3, 2025, in collaboration with AIMS International – The Association of Indian Management Scholars International. Anchored in the timely and thought-provoking theme, “Managing AI: Ethics, Risks, and Opportunities,” the conference brought together scholars, industry leaders, and practitioners to engage in critical conversations on technology, sustainability, and evolving global management practices.

Setting the tone for the conference, Prof. Omprakash K. Gupta, University of Houston–Downtown and Editor-in-Chief of the AIMS International Journal of Management, reflected on the inception and evolution of the AIMS International Conference on Management. The conference was further enriched by a compelling keynote address by Shri Subrat Tripathy, CEO, Adani Ports & SEZ, who offered a visionary outlook on the future of India’s maritime and logistics sectors. Highlighting strategic priorities for ports, he emphasized sustainability through reduced carbon footprints and the transformative role of AI in enhancing efficiency across supply chains. Drawing on India’s geographical advantage and historical context, he articulated an ambitious vision of a trillion-dollar economy, anchored in collective responsibility and the ethos of “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam”—the world as one family.

Throughout the deliberations, a unifying message resonated strongly: the path forward lies in embracing People, Planet, and Prosperity, while harnessing technology to build resilient, inclusive, and future-ready systems. WinterLude 2025: IIM Shillong Celebrates Christmas with Festive Cheer




